



Stamford Vision: Urban

Notes from the meeting on 30.03.04

1. Presentation by Placemarque: A paper copy of their presentation was handed out, if you would like a copy please ask CLH. Following a questions and answer session the consultants have undertaken to explore the issues raised and adapt the signage and process as necessary.
2. Litter inspector: Ian Simmonds was welcomed to the group as the new street cleaning inspector for the area. His area of responsibility covers Stamford and villages, in SKDC's region, up the A1 corridor as far as Woolsthorpe by Belvoir. He explained that he has a system of zones both for regular inspections and for frequency of cleaning. He agreed to bring along the map of the zones to the next meeting. The question of using the second machine to clean in the town was discussed and this is something which Ian is pursuing. 3. Traffic Issues: CLH's paper on car parking was distributed. Giles explained his brief and he agreed to circulate his paper of traffic issues once it has been updated to include the most recent meeting held. He is hoping to produce a paper on an overall parking strategy by mid June. GR explained that LCC will soon be holding a meeting to gather projects to form part of the CTZ which will be implemented in 2005/6.
4. Litter bins: 25 bins have been ordered. The associated installation costs will come out of the 2004/5 budget.
