

## Stamford Vision – Urban Group Meeting 19 March 2007

### Minutes

- 1 Apologies. Charles Crawford, Giles Hopkinson, Rob Fogle, Neil Partridge  
The Chairman welcomed and introduced Stevie Jackson to the meeting and wished Daniel Simons Good luck as he leaves SKDC this week, and thanked him for his work and contribution to Stamford Vision.
- 2 Matters Arising. Gateway Project. RB & GR undertook a footfall count on Friday (16<sup>th</sup>); the numbers were higher than in previous years at the same time.
- 3 Greening of Stamford. Peter Hayes reported on the progress he had made. He has held several meetings with groups and individuals to glean their views and elicit support throughout Stamford on this project. There are a number of actions to follow up. Peter will work with Charles Crawford and Stevie to produce a plan of action. Don expressed concern that safety needed to take priority over planting so that work was not vandalised.
