

## Stamford Vision: Urban

### Notes from the meeting on 13.10.04

1. Map presentation from Les Ball of Cityscape Maps. He showed the group the three dimensional map of Stamford which his team has been working on. He would like to put these up around town on the existing map locations. There would be a cast iron stand with the map (no advertising) and a map dispenser. The fold out map would cost £1 and would have some town information on it and about 8 adverts. Mr Ball is proposing to finance all the initial outlay. The map was generally welcomed although there are some details on the location of the maps, the material of the surround, the percentage contribution and the detail of the mapping to be agreed before the project can proceed. It was agreed that a working sub-group of CC,GR,JJ and CLH convene to work up the details. AH will check with LCC about the legal agreements which might need to be entered into and what the current agreements are. He will also check out the status of the new map which has appeared on the ramp up to the bus station.
2. Updates on:
  - a. Litter bins-RB reported that 18 bins have been installed. Two bins are going to be relocated and a number of the 'daleks' repositioned. GR agreed to accompany Ian Simmons in the van to collect up the excess bins and rationalise those that are left. JJ to speak to Azar Woods to find out if she has agreed to contribute, in addition to SV, to the additional bins (dalek type) on the Meadows. RK suggested that there should be an additional bin at the end of Water Furlong. RB agreed to re-do the bin schedule in early December.
  - b. Benches - A strategy for benches needs to be produced. TR to produce a summary page of photographs. JJ to look into replacing the picnic style benches on the Meadows and will arrange for one of the benches he has in store to go along the path by the most easterly part of the Mill Stream.
  - c. The River -7 benches on Water Street have been refurbished and 2 remain to be done - AH will instruct the contractor. DL will produce the photos of the southern bank and JK is working on a letter to residents.
  - d. Stamford in Bloom -RK updated the group on the activities of the group and a number of suggestions were made about groups which might get involved in the initiative. He has been concentrating on the Apple day and the Community Orchard project recently.
3. AOB:
  - a. Floral displays & Community Fund: AH asked that everyone think about where floral displays could be incorporated, suggestions included the bench at the Eastern end of the high Street, Castle Dyke and Albert Bridge. AH will provide information on the Community Fund.
  - b. Licensing: The draft policy is being consulted on at present - see attachment, comments can be made via SKDC's web site.
