

Stamford Vision: Urban

Notes from the meeting on 12.07.04

1. Membership: GR has had a request from Don Lambert to join the group as he is no longer representing Chamber of Trade on the strategy group. GR to contact him to welcome him to the working group.
2. Updates on
 - a. The River: JOK provided two reports which were circulated before the meeting.
 - Benches on Water Street: Following JOK's comprehensive survey it was agreed that their refurbishment should be undertaken and the budget allocated. Individual responsibilities listed below.
 - Other items of maintenance: See list below for action on trees/ cycle barrier.
 - Access to river: JK to contact Candy Reid about funding a study and follow up on the canoeist's survey.
 - Access alongside the river: CC to contact Duncan Lucas at SKDC about cycle access.
 - b. Stamford in Bloom: Clearing of the judges route took place on Sunday. Replanting of the containers in Sheep Market is complete. AH has spoken to the service team and they will water them if they can.
 - c. Traffic issues: A meeting is taking place on the 16 July of the informal parking group. LCC will be holding the first meeting on the CTZ over the summer, date not known.
Litter bins: 21 bins will be delivered to the LCC depot at Thurlby next week. The bins will be removed for refurbishment at the same time as the new bins are installed. AH had received a quote from Andrew Cook, an SKDC contractor who could do the refurbishment of the bins and the installation in about 4 to 6 weeks. It was agreed that he should go ahead asap.
Signposts: Agreed to refurbish and install one new finger post and three existing ones.
3. AOB:
 - a. Telegraph pole: Removal of visually intrusive poles to be pursued by GR, CLH to provide contact details at BT.
 - b. Posts by bus ramp: JJ would like these removed. The ownership of that land will be investigated by AH as a first step.
 - c. Lampposts: Two new lampposts and the repainting of several will take place through the Gateway project.
4. Funds agreed to be spent:
 - Water Street: up to £500
 - Plastic bins refurbishment £60
 - Metal bins refurbishment £800
 - Finger post refurbishment £480
 - Finger post installation £100
 - Bollard painting at the end of Castle Dyke £180
 - Planter in High Street repainting £40
 - Installation of new bins at £42 each £882
 - Total £3,042**
